

Because you have exclusive use of the property, the rooms are taken on a self catering basis. Here's how that splits out:

Hoath House - 5 ensuite rooms

The Tudor Wing - seven rooms. One ensuite and six further rooms sharing three bathrooms

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



1. How can I get to you?

A link to our location on Google Maps can be found here, and a link to the map of the grounds can be found here.

The house is signed from the road postcode TN8 7DB

On arrival follow the signs for Hoath House go past the main car park on the old tennis court and head onto the smaller Service car park to be able to unload. Cars should then be transferred to the main car park.

2. What is the minimum/maximum number of guests?

Maximum reception 220 (Marquee) Maximum reception Inside 140, Maximum Ceremony and reception 110.

3. Is Hoath House wheelchair accessible?

The house can be reached from the car park without steps across the lawn. There are three steps up to the ceremony room and two steps down to the nearest bedroom.

4. How late can the party go on until?

Non staying guests leave at midnight. Staying guests are free to continue as long as they wish in the house if the accommodation has been booked.

5. Can I have music at my event?

Yes Bands and DJs are welcome. Music outside will finish in time for non staying guests to leave.

6. Can suppliers come before and leave their equipment?

For our full package you can begin to leave equipment and baggage at the house from 10am. The ground floor will be available from 12 and the bedrooms from 3pm.

7. Is there more information about the layout of the house and rooms?

8. What happens upon arrival?

A member of staff will meet you on arrival and give an introductory brief (10 minutes) and answer any questions. They will be on hand for your stay during working hours for questions from suppliers and in an emergency overnight.
